Maison Kerlann Bourgogne Pinot Noir Fut de Chene H 2009
Burgundy, France

Maison Kerlann focus on high quality general wines and considers that the unique and rare cuvees of Bourgogne can only be acquired through the domaines themselves. Nevertheless they produce high quality wines honestly, with passion and simplicity and are a valid entry level of Bourgogne wines.



Tasting Note: This grenat coloured Pinot Noir, Cote De Nuits Style, has an intense expression of the soil, powerful red fruits: cherries, blackcurrant and prunes.

Damilano Lecinquevigne Barolo 2004
Piedmont, Italy (RP 88)

As the name suggests, Damilano's entry-level 2004 Barolo Lecinquevigne is made from five vineyards in the villages of Barolo, Castiglione Falletto and Monforte, and is aged in a combination of Slavonian and French oak.



Tasting Note: Tar, smoke, earthiness and black cherries emerge as this Barolo flows from the glass, showing unusually refined tannins for this bottling. Anticipated maturity: 2009-2018.

Chateau Sociando Mallet 1999
Haut Medoc, France

One of those châteaux which makes a mockery of the 1855 classification of Bordeaux. Never entered into the classification of Cru Classé châteaux, and subsequently classified as a Cru Bourgeois in 1932.



Tasting Note: Sociando Mallet's opaque ruby/purple-colored 1999 reveals notes of wet steel, liquified minerals, black cherries/black currants, and subtle wood. Aromatically, there is not much difference between this wine and a renowned classified growth such as Leoville Las Cases.

Paul Jaboulet Hermitage La Chapelle Blanc 2006
Rhone, France (RP 93)

The rare 3,000-bottle cuvee of 100% Marsanne, the 2006 Hermitage La Chapelle blanc (the first vintage of this wine made since 1961).



Tasting Note: Complex white wine displaying notes of crushed rocks, flowers, quince, white currants, and white peaches. Very full-bodied with superb acidity and freshness, this is a stunning effort.
